Our Multiplier Events, held in all partner countries, have showcased the unique contributions of each region and celebrated the project's successes. We are excited to share with you the highlights from each partner country:

### Spain

Hosted by DIPUTACIÓN PROVINCIAL DE VALLADOLID and Formative Footprint, the Spanish multiplier events took place in October in the Towns of Peñaflor de Hornija and Íscar, (Valladolid) with an attendance of more than 80 persons. The participants included educators, seniors enthusiastic about the project and open to engaging in similar initiatives, directors of educational institutions, tourism technicians, trainers specializing in adult education and digital skills and professionals from the tourism industry. The attendees agreed to mention that the project really let them to be closer to the digital world.



### Poland

Hosted by Stowarzyszenie Szukamy Polski multiplier events in Poland took place in September in Supraśl near Białystok with an attendance of 55 people. They were participants in the Congress of Podlasie Senior Citizens' Councils: activists from senior citizens' organizations, representatives of local authorities, local tourism organizers, teachers. Participants at the meeting appreciated the great potential of the project, above all for the promotion of local tourism. During the discussion, they highlighted the potential for intergenerational cooperation through joint work on a video narrated by seniors.



## Greece

E-SCHOOL Educational Group hosted the Greek multiplier event in Karditsa on October 24, 2024, bringing together a diverse group of participants, including adult trainers, seniors, educational center directors, tourism professionals, and local politicians. The event successfully showcased the project's key outputs, such as the training program, videos, web platform, and methodological guide, which were well-received by attendees. The event facilitated lively discussions and valuable feedback, emphasizing the importance of enhancing digital skills among seniors and highlighting the positive impact of such initiatives on community engagement and local development.
